His work has taken him to many places in the US, Europe, Latin America, and Korea. He has also visited Palestine, Israel, Bahrain, and Iraq, and recently returned from his third visit to Afghanistan. A lifelong peace activist, Brian has been arrested and jailed many times in actions for peace and human rights. In 2012-2013, he served a six-month prison sentence for protesting drone killing from Whiteman Air Force Base in Missouri.
